Todd won eight awards as drum major of the band. He attended All-State band for four years, quad state band for two years, and UTM honor band for three years.

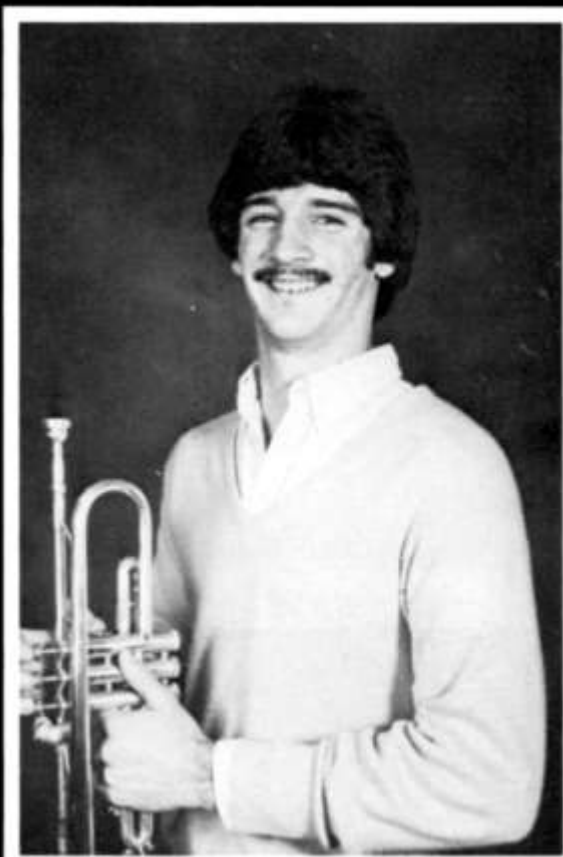


Todd Dowdy and Lisa Thompson were elected by the senior class as Mr. and Miss Senior, the highest honor awarded to a senior by ones peers.

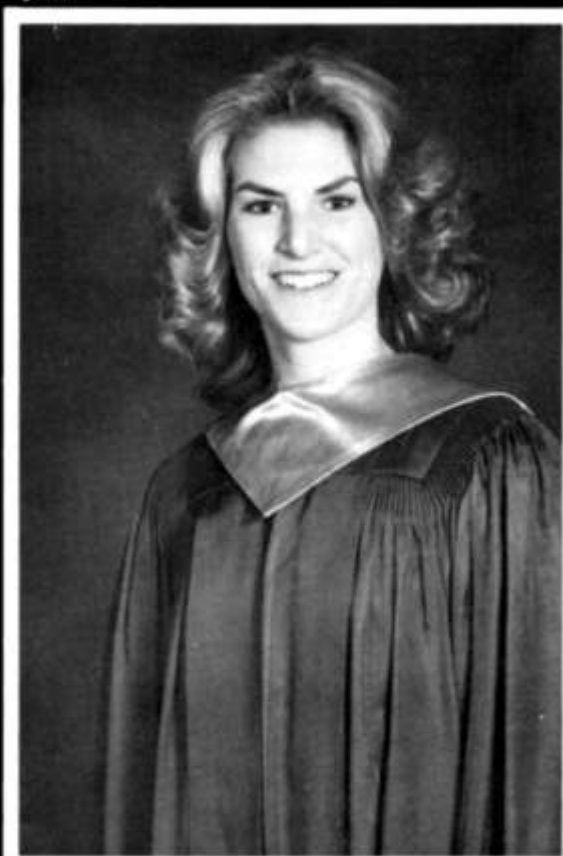
Mr. and Miss L.O.H.S. — Andy Burch, Lisa Thompson
