This path leads to a "munch" needed lunch break! Students hurry to the cafeteria in hopes that Mr. Rushing will not catch them cutting line.




After gobbling the tasty (?) food, everyone congregates in the senior hall to share gossips, gripes, and anything else there is to discuss.


An Improving Season!

At last the evening came to a closing, but the memories of Prom '87 will last forever for those who attended.




