

### FORMER PLAYERS WHO STILL CARE

This year we salute two former Lone Oak tennis players who have never lost interest in their high school team. Through college and after, they have continued to return to the Lone Oak courts to watch their team and to practice with the team members. Alumni like them are part of the reason the teams have remained strong long after they have graduated.



### Stephanie Edwards

Stephanie is the daughter of Mr. & Mrs. Howard C. Edwards. She played on the Lone Oak Varsity Tennis Team for three years, with a record of 46 and 5 in Singles and 36 and 8 in Doubles. Stephanie graduated in 1983 as the No. 1 seed with an undefeated season for the year in Singles and Doubles. In addition she played in junior tournaments in which she was ranked in the Top-10 in the state for three years in a row. After graduation, Stephanie attended Murray State University as a freshman walk-on for the tennis team, alternating No. 6 & 7 position. As a sophomore and junior on a partial tennis scholarship, she played the No. 5 and No. 4 positions respectively with winning seasons both years. Stephanie finished third in Singles in the Ohio Valley Conference her sophomore year as did the team overall. In 1987, Stephanie graduated from Murray State University with a B.S. degree in Elementary Education and is a math teacher at the Lone Oak Middle School. She has continued playing tennis since graduation in addition to teaching tennis. This year Stephanie is also serving as our assistant tennis team coach.



### Russell Sloan

Russell is the son of Joe and Dorothy Sloan. He played on the Lone Oak Varsity Tennis Team for three years. He graduated in 1981 with a record of 32 and 6 in Singles and 23 and 10 in Doubles. He was an Honor Student and a National Merit Finalist. Russell attended Murray State University receiving a Bachelor of Science in Business Administration in 1985 and his MBA in 1987. During his undergraduate days, he was the tennis team's manager and an instructor in many of Coach Purcell's tennis camps during the summers. ### TEAM HISTORY

The Boys' Tennis Team was started in 1972 and has never had a losing season. The team's overall record is 216 wins with 56 losses. Four of the best seasons were: 1978 (19-0), 1985 (20-0), 1986 (19-1), and 1988 (19-1). The Boys' Team was tied for 4th Place in Kentucky in 1986, and in 1988 they finished in 4th Place in Kentucky.

The Girls' Tennis Team was started in 1979 and has never had a losing season. The team's overall record is 154 wins with only 16 losses. In 1982 and 1983, the team was 20-0. During the 1981 to 1984 seasons, the Girls' Team won 59 consecutive high school team matches. In state competition the Girls' Team finished 9th in 1982, 3rd in 1983, 5th in 1984, 7th in 1985, and tied for 2nd Place in Kentucky in 1988. They were awarded 3rd Place based on number of games won.

The Girls and Boys have both won numerous individual regional titles in Singles and Doubles. Three of the keys that have built the Lone Oak Tennis Team's winning tradition are: a dedicated coach, supportive parents, and a Junior Varsity that develops players mentally and physically for the future.


### WE ARE LONE OAK

### COACH HEFLIN

Mr. Heflin has been teaching math at Lone Oak High School since 1972. A Paducah Tilghman High School graduate in 1967, he is also a graduate of Murray State University, obtaining a Bachelor of Science degree in Mathematics in 1971, and a Master of Arts in Teaching (Mathematics) degree in 1977.



Coach Heflin initiated the tennis program at Lone Oak in 1972 with a Boys' Team of six players. In 1979, he began coaching the Girls' program. He has built the program, in just a few years, to one of the most respected programs in the state. In addition to coaching, Mr. Heflin is an avid on-court player, and one of the top players in Kentucky and is competitive in many southern states. He has been a member of the United States Professional Tennis Association since 1978, holding Professional 1 rank, and he has also been a member of the United States Tennis Association since 1974. He is considered the best individual coach in the area, with more coaching requests than he can accept.

When Larry is not on the courts, he enjoys racquetball, billiards, and reading. He realizes that no coach can build a strong program by himself. When asked about the Lone Oak program, he says, "I feel very strongly that our program here at Lone Oak is the best tennis program in the state. This is due to the tremendous support of the parents and the exceptional commitment of the players."

Larry and his wife, Connie, live at 8145 Houser Road. We are very fortunate to have such a talented and dedicated coach at Lone Oak.



### OUR SENIORS

This year we have five Seniors on the Team. All five started playing matches for the Varsity in middle school, and have been a major factor in the team's successes during the last five to six years. They have a combined record of 195 and 27 in Singles and 153 and 44 in Doubles. Not only has this group been successful on the tennis court, they have excelled in many other areas also.

All five plan to attend college next year. Lana, Chad and Richard have chosen Murray State; while Shari will attend Union University in Jackson, Tennessee; and Jody will attend Boston University. Lana, Shari, Chad and Richard also plan to play college tennis next year. Very few high schools will have five Seniors with the combined academic and tennis skills as does Lone Oak this year. With graduation in May, we wish each of them the very best, for all their endeavors, in the future.

### 1988 - A YEAR TO REMEMBER

Last year was truly a year to remember in Lone Oak Tennis. It was the best combined year to date. The combined teams were 39 and 1 for the year. Both teams won the Regionals, which was our goal, but it did not end there. At State we had one Boys' and both Girls' Doubles Teams make it to the semifinals. 


# Shari Brantley


# Nicki Edwards


# Jennifer Clouser





# Ashley Gholson






## Peyton Jones


# Shannon Mungle


# Michael Foster


## Louis Tick
