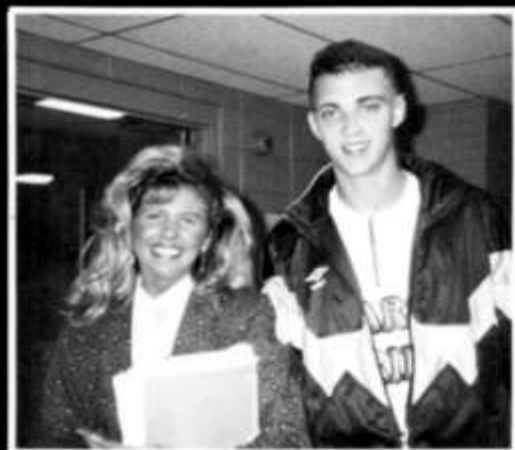

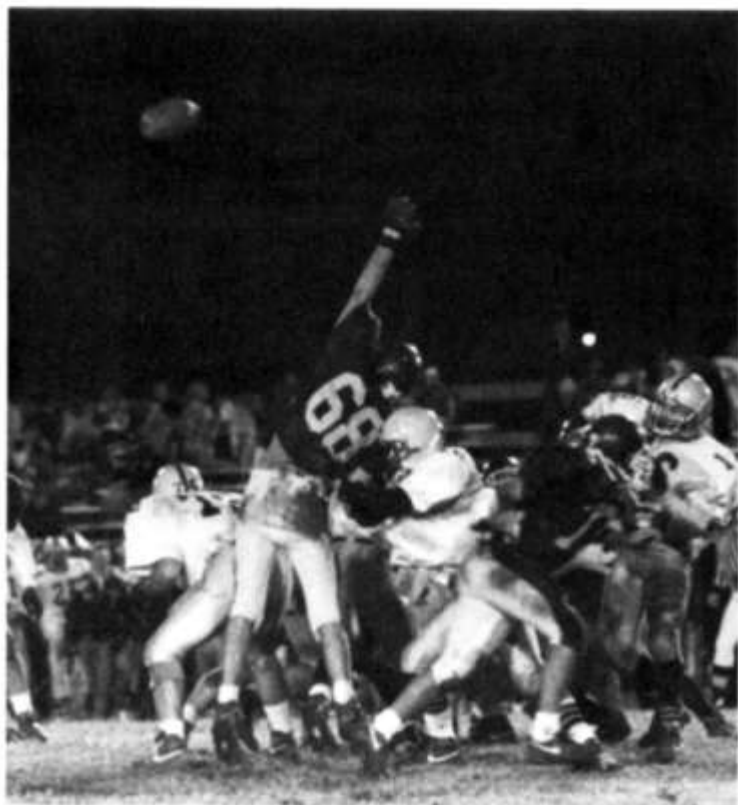

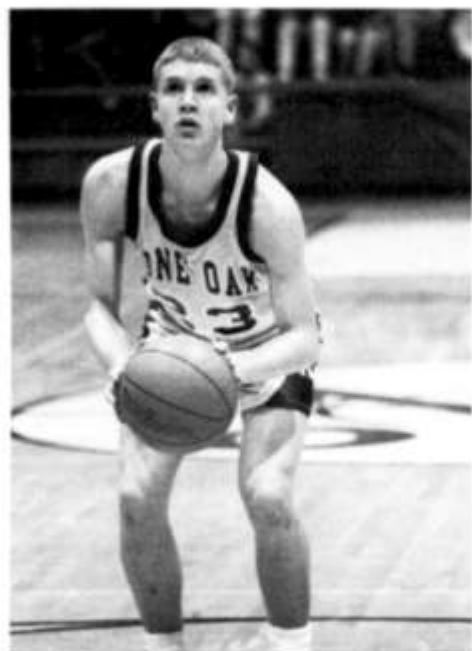

The team will continue to work hard and **strive to be the best**. Good luck team!

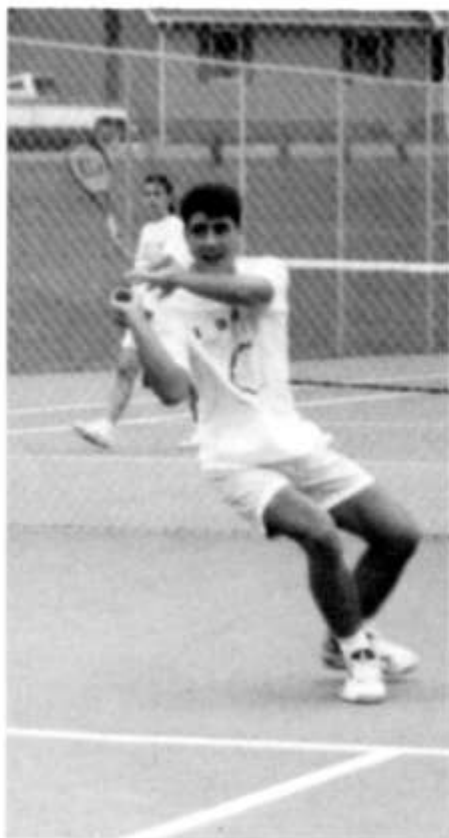

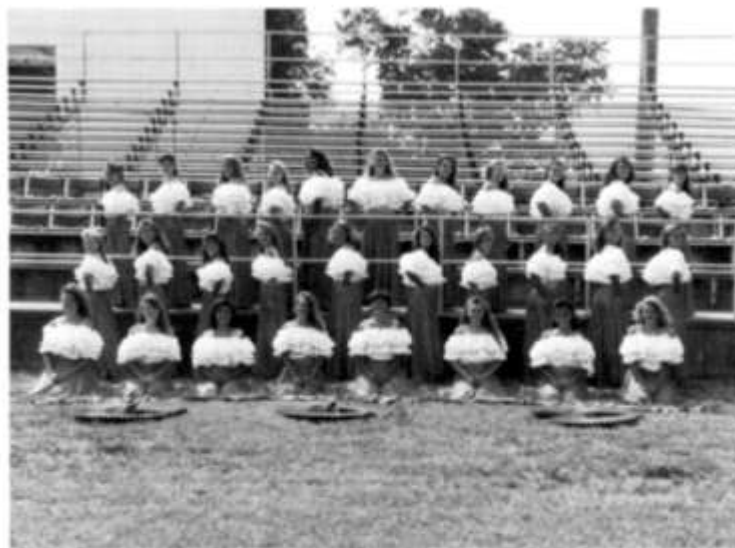
