The month of February saw a huge drop in overall, major, and minor incidents compared to last February. Overall, discipline referrals decreased from 9.50 to 5.89 per day.

Major discipline referrals dropped from 5.05 last year to 3.42 this year, a decrease of 1.63. Minor write-ups showed a similar decrease, going from 4.45 per day last year in February to 2.47 this year.

Significantly, over the past four years we have shown a decrease in students who are tardy. By the end of February during the 2009-2010 year we had totaled 2,117 tardies. This year we are at 1,239, a decrease of 878 tardies.
